	What Athlete has to do	Selection Process	Selection Date/s
2018 ICF U23 World Championships	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Must be eligible* (see cl 2.1 of Policy) to compete for NZ; and, - Must compete in the 2018 CRNZ National Champs Regatta in a K1 Open Event (200, 500 or 1000) for which the K1 Athlete is seeking selection; and - Must compete in a selection trial (if eligible) if a trial is required by CRNZ (Step 2) 	<p>The process for selecting K1 Athletes for 2018 ICF U23 World Championships is as follows:</p> <p><u>STEP 1: National Championships (23-25 February 2018)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Athletes must compete in the distance for which they seek selection ie K1 200, 500 or 1000 event. All events will be Open. - Selectors then assess the results of the first and second placed U23 athletes in the Open final of each event, along with any Other Factors (such as test results, other assessments, and relationships) to decide if they are satisfied that either or both of these K1 Athletes are capable of reaching the performance criteria ie an A Final at the U23 World Championships - If the Selectors consider that both first and second placed K1 U23 Athletes satisfy the performance criteria, these athletes will be invited to a Selection Trial (Step 2) - If only the first placed or the second placed U23 K1 athlete satisfies the performance criteria, that Athlete will be the selected athlete for that event for the U23 World Championships. - If none of the first and second placed athletes satisfy the criteria, there will be no athletes selected to the U23 World Championships for that event. <p><u>STEP 2: Selection Trial (5 March 2018)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The format of the Selection Trial will be such number of races as are necessary in each event (eg K1 200, K1 500 and K1 1000) until a K1 Athlete in each event is first placed on two occasions. - The K1 U23 Athlete in each trial for an Event who is first to achieve first place in two races will be selected for the U23 World Championships. - The K1 Athlete in each event who was first placed U23 Athlete at CRNZ National Champs will count as one first place for that event. 	<p>30 March 2018</p> <p>and 15 June 2018 (late selection if required)</p>

2018 ICF U23 World Championships	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Must be eligible* (refer cl 2.1 of Policy) to compete for NZ; and - Must be a member of the High Performance Squad or the Paddle to Podium Squad and participated in any camps (see separate CRNZ HP Squad Selection Policy and CRNZ High Performance Athlete Pathway for Paddle to Podium); and, - Must compete in the 2018 CRNZ National Champs Regatta in a K1 Open Event. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Selectors shall select U23 Crew Athletes, from which the CRNZ Coaches will (in consultation with Selectors) decide the Crews. - The Selectors must be satisfied that the U23 Crew Athlete has the capability as a member of a Crew of achieving A Final or better in an Event the U23 World Championships. - In deciding capability, the Selectors shall take into account any one or more of the following results and performances of Crew Athletes and Crews <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o 2018 ICF (Open) World Cups o 2017 U23 World Championships o Crew boat testing and other assessments during camps and training sessions. - The Selectors may also look at: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Assessment data undertaken by CRNZ o Relationships with other athletes and support/coach team o Crew boat compatibility 	30 Mar 2018 and 15 June 2018 (late selection if required)
