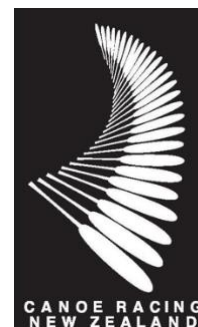


## CANOE RACING NEW ZEALAND

### SELECTION POLICY – 2019 ASIA PACIFIC SPRINT REGATTA – K1 EVENTS

#### KARAPIRO, NEW ZEALAND



## 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 **Aims:** CRNZ's aim in selecting Athletes to compete in the 2019 Asia Pacific Sprint Regatta is to provide development opportunities for young Athletes.

1.2 **CRNZ Selection Regulations:** You should read this Policy in conjunction with the CRNZ Selection Regulations ("**Regulations**"). In particular, you should be aware of:

- (a) the process you need to follow if you feel you have been affected by Exceptional Circumstances (see clause 10 of the Regulations); and
- (b) the process you must follow if you wish to make an Appeal in respect of any aspect of the Selection process (see clause 11 of the Regulations).

1.3 **Definitions:** Where a word is capitalised it will have a definition. Definitions can be found in Appendix 1 of the Regulations.

1.4 **Regatta and Events:** This document sets what you need to do to be selected to compete in the Asia Pacific Sprint Regatta in the following Events:

(a) **Specified Events** (see clause 5 of the Regulations)

(b) **Additional Events:** CRNZ may select Athletes or Crews to compete in events other than those listed in the table above – see clause 7 of the Regulations

1.5 Athletes who wish to be considered for Selection must complete an Athlete Application form by the Application Date set out in the table at clause 1.6 below (see clause 4.1 of the Regulations). This form is available on the CRNZ website.

1.6 **Important Dates:** The following are the key dates for this Policy:

1.7 **Cost:** As the Asia Pacific Regatta will be held in New Zealand, Athletes may make their own transport and accommodation arrangements.

## 2. PROCESS

2.1 **Outline:** In order to be selected, you need to:

- (a) meet all of the Eligibility Criteria – see Part 2 of the Regulations; and
- (b) compete in the Trial – see Part 3 of the Regulations
- (c) meet the Performance Criteria below – see Part 4 of the Regulations (subject to any Exceptional Circumstances).

## 3. NOMINATION - TRIAL

3.1 **Pre-conditions:** You must fulfil the following pre-conditions:

- (a) compete in the 2019 CRNZ Sprint Nationals in a K1 Event
  - (i) u16 Athletes must compete in a u16 K1 Event;
  - (ii) u18 Athletes must compete in a u18 K1 Event; and
  - (iii) u21 Athletes must compete in an open K1 Event; and

3.2 **Trial:** The Trial for K1 Events, except U16 MK1 1000, will be the Final of the 2019 CRNZ Sprint National Championship (u21 results will be taken from the Open Finals). The top 3 Athletes in each K1 Event will be Nominated for the same Event at the Asia Pacific Sprint Regatta.

3.3 **U16 MK1 1000 Trial:** Because there is no U16 MK1 1000 race at the CRNZ Sprint Nationals, the trial for the U16 MK1 1000 will be held at the Asia Pacific Training and Seat Trial Camp (see the table at clause 1.6 and the Asia Pacific Crew Selection Policy). The top 3 Athletes at that Trial will earn Nomination. All MK U16 Athletes at the camp may compete in the Trial.

## 4. PERFORMANCE CRITERIA AND SELECTION

4.1 **Performance Criteria:** There are no Performance Criteria for the Asia Pacific Regatta. Athletes who earn Nomination will automatically be Selected.

4.2 **Selection:** If Selected, you must complete a CRNZ Athlete Agreement within 10 days of the Selection Date.
